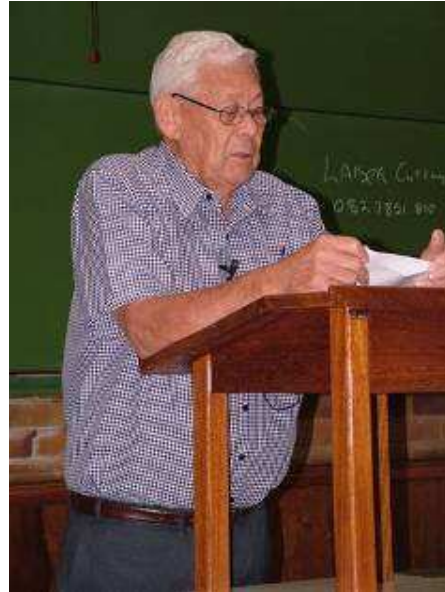

Objectives for 2011

The Committee examined the overall objectives for the year in the light of the Constitutional Aims and Objectives (Clause 3 of the Constitution). The following ten objectives for 2011 were identified and will be reviewed at each of the Management Committee meetings.

Programme 2011

The first meeting of the year was mainly devoted to the setting of the programme for 2011. Eight members attended the get-together on 8 January at the workshop of Paul Roberts.

Each member was requested to have at least one **Project** for the year which could be displayed at the 2011 Exhibition which will probably be held in August. The theme for the Project could be something useful for the workshop such as a router table, but could be any other cabinet work.

The programme for the year will include **practical demonstrations and hands-on experience** of various aspects of **cabinet making**. Participants are requested to bring appropriate ear protection.

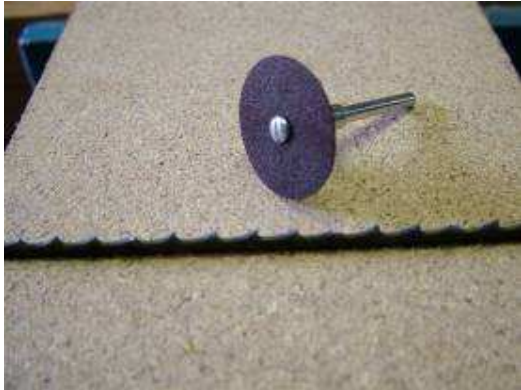
The following programme was agreed upon:

- Biscuit joints (12 February, Brian's workshop)
- Planing (surfacing and thicknessing) (March)
- Sawing (April)
- Band sawing
- Jointing
- Hand tools
- Sharpening
- Glues and glueing techniques
- Finishing

The Cabinet Makers meet on the second Saturday of each month at 09h00 until about 11h00.

Each meeting will also have a "show-and-tell" item where members can show new techniques or raise problems. Brian showed how he sharpened a band saw blade using a Dremel cut-off wheel. The photograph illustrates the holding jig which has a slot cut into it for

holding the blade. The jig is clamped into the bench vice. The Dremel is set at its lowest speed and the cut-off wheel is touched lightly on the back face of each tooth. The blade should be cleaned well before sharpening. Paint stripper is a useful cleaning agent, and gloves should be worn. Wash well with water after cleaning.

Draaiers se hoekie

Die nuwe jaar het begin en 'n nuwe jaarprogram moet vir ons draaiers-aktiwiteite saamgestel word. Dit was dan ook, tesame met ons huiswerkbespreking, die hoofdoel van ons eerste byeenkoms daar in Dries du Toit se werksplek. Ons sou graag aan die begin van die jaar al ons draaiers daar wou hê om met hierdie beplanning te help, want elkeen se mening en voorkeure/afkeure is vir ons belangrik om van kennis te neem. Talle lede het egter geldige verskonings aangebied en kon dit nie bywoon nie. Die ongeveer 20 draaiers teenwoordig het egter goeie rekenskap van hulself gegee en praktiese idees voorgestel. Dit sal in ons program vir vanjaar opgeneem word.

Daar moet ook iets oor Jack Munting gesê word. Hy het die draaiers se leisels by twee reuse in ons groep, te wete At Smit en Willie de Wet, oorgeneem en hom baie goed van sy taak gekwyd. Ons wens Jack alles van die beste toe in hierdie nuwe rol, en weet by voorbaat dat hy 'n sukses daarvan sal maak. Hy het goeie voorbeelde om na te volg. Baie sterkte Jack. Ons sal jou al die pad ondersteun.

Hoewel die "amptelike" huiswerk 'n draaistuk was wat slegs tussen senters gedraai moes wees, het die meeste lede teenwoordig 'n ei keuse verkies wat nie net of glad nie tussen senters gedraai is nie. Die hoofrede vir die slegs-tussen-senters-draaistuk was om die draaiers te stimuleer en interessante ontwerpe uit te lok vir deelname later vanjaar aan Schalk van Niekerk se soortgelyke uitdaging wat hy aan alle AWSA-lede gerig het. Aan die ander kant was die groot verskeidenheid draaistukke baie uiteenlopend en baie interessant (kyk foto's). Dit het my weereens getref hoe oorspronklik ons lede is en in welke mate talle draaiers se handewerk getuig van vordering en ontwikkeling in terme van ontwerp, draaitegnieke en afwerking.

Met die bespreking van die draaihuiswerk het daar weer eens kostelike stukkie inligting en interessantheite uitgekom. Dit is baie duidelik dat hierdie groep draaiers geen reservering of terughouding ken wanneer dit kom by raadgee en hulp aanbied nie. Natuurlik was daar ook die nou reeds bekende klip-in-die-bos-vraag deur At Smit. Hy wou by almal weet hoe 'n hamersteel gedraai word. Dit het nogal vir 'n opwindende bespreking gesorg, maar dit is nie duidelik of almal die antwoord mooi gesnap het nie. Dalk moet At later aan ons demonstreer hoe presies dit op 'n standaard draaibank gedoen word.

Na pouse se koffie-en-beskuit (baie dankie Margret) het At Smit ons vergas met 'n uiters interessante verduideliking en demonstrering van al die soorte beitels wat in tussen-senters-draaiwerk gebruik word. Dit het my weereens opgeval dat dit nie net gaan oor kennis nie,

maar dat ervaring/oefening/bedrewenheid besonder belangrik is wanneer netjies en presies gedraai moet word. Hiermee saam het At oor en oor beklemtoon dat jou beitels te alle tye SKERP moet wees, anders gaan jy sukkel en probleme ervaar en ontevrede met die eindresultaat wees - wat jou dan sal noop om baie te skuur. Gewis baie stof tot nadenke.
